

Atma Meek is an Austin-based community strategist working where homelessness, behavioral health, and justice involvement overlap. Having lived through incarceration and housing instability, Atma brings more than two decades of recovery leadership and frontline service into regional conversations about systems change. That perspective is grounded in real-world practice, not theory.

His work includes community-based violence prevention and conflict transformation practice grounded in both lived experience and peace and conflict studies.

In program leadership at The Other Ones Foundation, Atma helps shape and scale initiatives that support sustainable housing, employment pathways, and whole-person wellbeing. The focus is simple: build programs that work in real life and produce outcomes that matter.
